## Commentary

Throughout the 24 hours the market was prevalently long and the margins remained satisfactory despite the national demand increase due to wintry weather conditions. Overnight power flow restrictions on the network boundary between Scotland and England were in place and were solved with BM actions. Significant volumes of buy trades on interconnectors were carried out from the afternoon to solve an import constraint in the south of England. These were supported by offers accepted in the BM. Overnight, the voltage levels in North of England and in Wales were regulated through trades on generating units. In addition, further trades on interconnectors were undertaken to manage RoCoF.
