Commentary

The market was short in excess of 1200MW overnight. After midnight, around 190MW of STOR was run as demand was out turning higher than forecast. Additionally, interconnectors were traded for frequency response. Over the morning peak, up to 200MW of STOR were deployed as demand was higher than forecast. Additional dynamic response was held during the darkness peak for TV pick-up risk. Voltage levels were managed in England with a mix of trades and BM actions. From the late evening, BM actions were required to solve power flow restrictions in Scotland. RoCoF was secured overnight with trades on interconnectors and on generating units.
