



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources	Today: Sunshine and showers, heavy with hail and thunder across Northern Ireland, northern England and Scotland, the latter seeing torrential downpours in the northeast. Scattered showers for southeast England, but generally fewer showers elsewhere. Breezy for England, Wales and northern Scotland. Tonight: Showers will fade for most leaving a dry but fresher night with clear spells. Scattered showers will continue across Scotland, but these will steadily become less frequent and less intense.
