Commentary

The market was long for most of the day. Multiple trades on the interconnectors were undertaken over the 24 hours for downward regulation.

Due to high wind generation and low demand, numerous actions in the BM were required overnight to solve power flow restrictions. Additionally, large volume of trades on interconnectors and generating units were required to control the voltage levels in England and to secure RoCoF, throughout the day. Voltage regulation also required the support of BM actions along the day.
