Current Situation

- ◆ No current provision in CUSC for recording in Amendment Reports a collective Panel Recommendation on whether an Amendment better facilitates the Applicable CUSC Objectives

Proposed Amendment

- ◆ In the event of the Panel making a collective Amendments Panel Recommendation, in the event of a tie, the Amendments Panel Chairman should not have a casting vote. The tie should be recorded and the Amendment is capable of being appealed.

Applicable CUSC Objectives

- ◆ Licence Objective (a) and (b) - Allowing NGC to facilitate the efficient discharge by the licensee of the obligations imposed upon it under the Act and by this licence, also it would help to facilitate competition in generation and supply.
- ◆ Ensures CUSC is aligned with the new Appeals mechanism.
- ◆ Increase information available to Authority thereby assisting in the decision making process regarding exclusion from Appeals.
