


Background

- CUSC decisions excluded where Authority decisions in line with Panel Recommendations
- Section for recording Panel Members Views
- No obvious mechanism for collective decision
- CUSC out of step with UNC and BSC

Applicable Objectives

- Better facilitates Applicable Objectives
- Allows NGC to discharge Licence Obligations by ensuring that provision of CUSC properly facilitate the Appeals mechanism
- Helps facilitate competition in generation and supply by ensuring Authority can receive a clear Panel Recommendation to assist it.
