CMP317 Identification and exclusion of Assets Required for Connection when setting Generator Transmission Network Use of System (TNUoS) charges And CMP327 Removing the Generator Residual from TNUoS Charges

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Key areas of discussion

The Workgroup discussed the following:

- Since the last CMP317 workgroup, Ofgem have directed National Grid ESO to raise CMP327 “Removing the Generator Residual from TNUoS Charges”, as part of the Authority’s Targeted Charging Review [decision](#).
- CUSC Panel recommended to amalgamate these modifications however Ofgem currently has not approved this. As such, they are being considered as two separate modifications, assessed by a single workgroup, who will develop the solutions for both.
- The workgroup revisited the original solution of CMP317, as proposed by National Grid ESO. The content and progress of this modification was re-capped for the benefit of new workgroup members. The ESO also outlined the proposed solution for CMP327.
- The workgroup continued their work on around potential alternatives for CMP317, with the workgroup members revising forward various permutations based on three modules:
 1. Definitions of Assets required for Connection
 2. Where in the range should be targeted
 3. Error Margins
- The workgroup will be meeting again on 22 January 2019 to further develop solutions for both modifications, working towards a consultation period in February.
