Commentary

The market alternated long and short, being short early morning to midday, and short from late afternoon onwards. Around 400MW of STOR was run around 6am.

Trades were required to manage localised power flow constraints in the Scotland area all day. BM Actions alleviated thermal export constraints in Scotland during the morning to midday, and from early afternoon onwards into the night. Overnight Voltage Control supported by Trades and BM Actions in the South/South East, Midlands, Wales and North East. Interconnector Trades all day for RoCoF, with some brief BM Action to support.
