Key areas of discussion

The Workgroup discussed the following:

- This meeting of GC0141 concentrated solely on the modelling requirements. The workgroup began by discussing Independent engineer verification. The workgroup was advised that the ESO and Ofgem had had conversations around this matter, and it was agreed that Ofgem would attend an upcoming meeting to help the workgroup understand the requirements needed moving forwards.
- The proposer took the workgroup through a presentation on modelling to frame the discussion. The slides are available [here](#).
- The workgroup spent substantial time discussing both RMS and EMT models. This included discussions around the current use of both models and suitability moving forwards. The benefits of both models were discussed further, and how this would impact the work on the modification moving forwards.
- The workgroup also gave consideration to how models were being used in other markets worldwide, and the relevance to the GB market.
- Sharing of models and compatibility of models were also at the forefront of discussion.
- The workgroup was advised by the Code Administrator that further meetings would be scheduled pending prioritisation discussions at Grid Code Review Panel.
