## **Offer Review Period**

The 3 month period between the issue of your offer and the offer expiry date

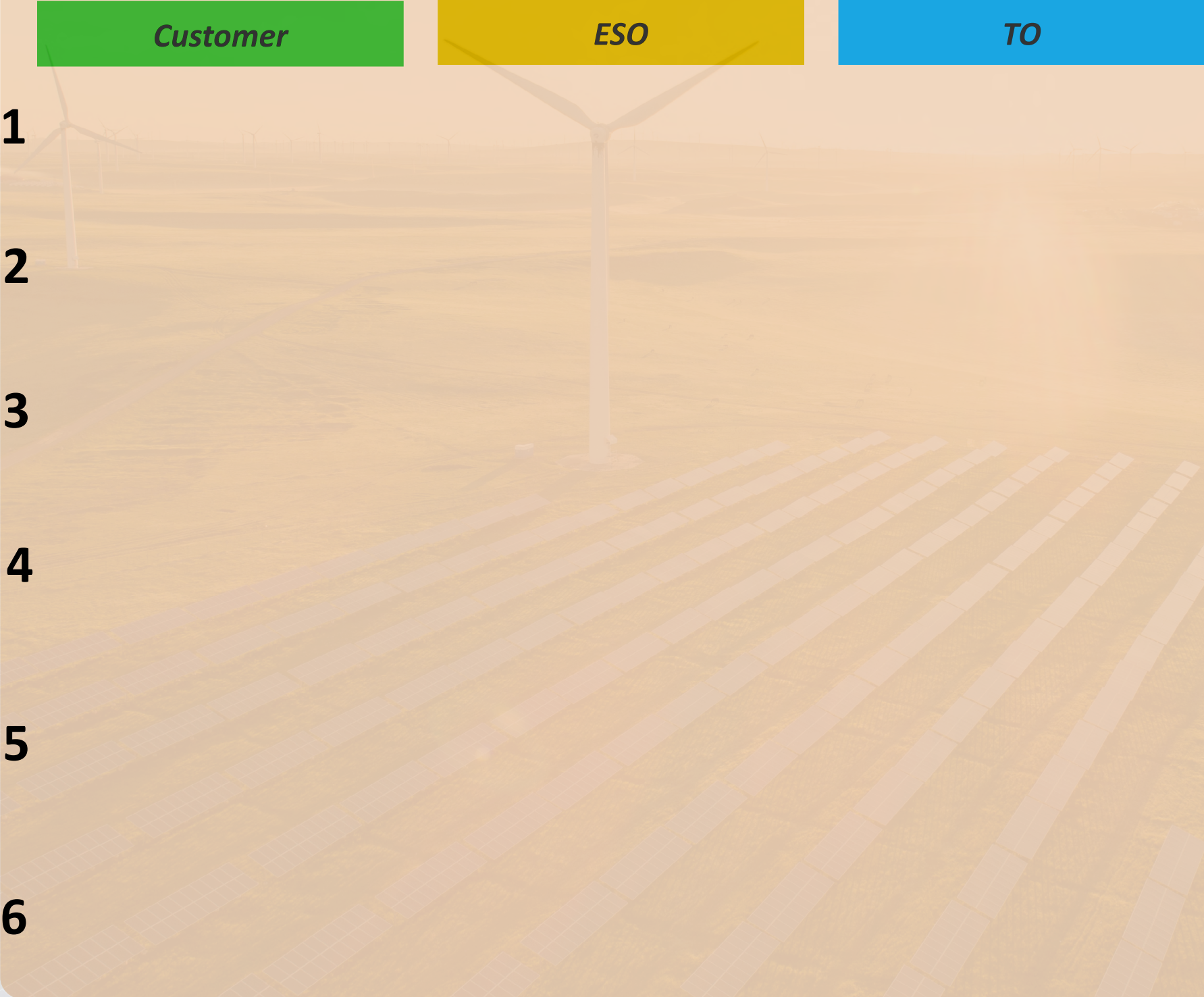
## **Continuous Engagement**

Ongoing engagement with your ESO Connections Contract Manager (CCM) throughout the life of your project



The pre-application stage of the connections process is all about information gathering. The ESO will require information from you regarding your project and will also provide you with all the information you need on the connections process. The TO will also be involved at this stage to give an indicative view of likely transmission works and connection timescales.

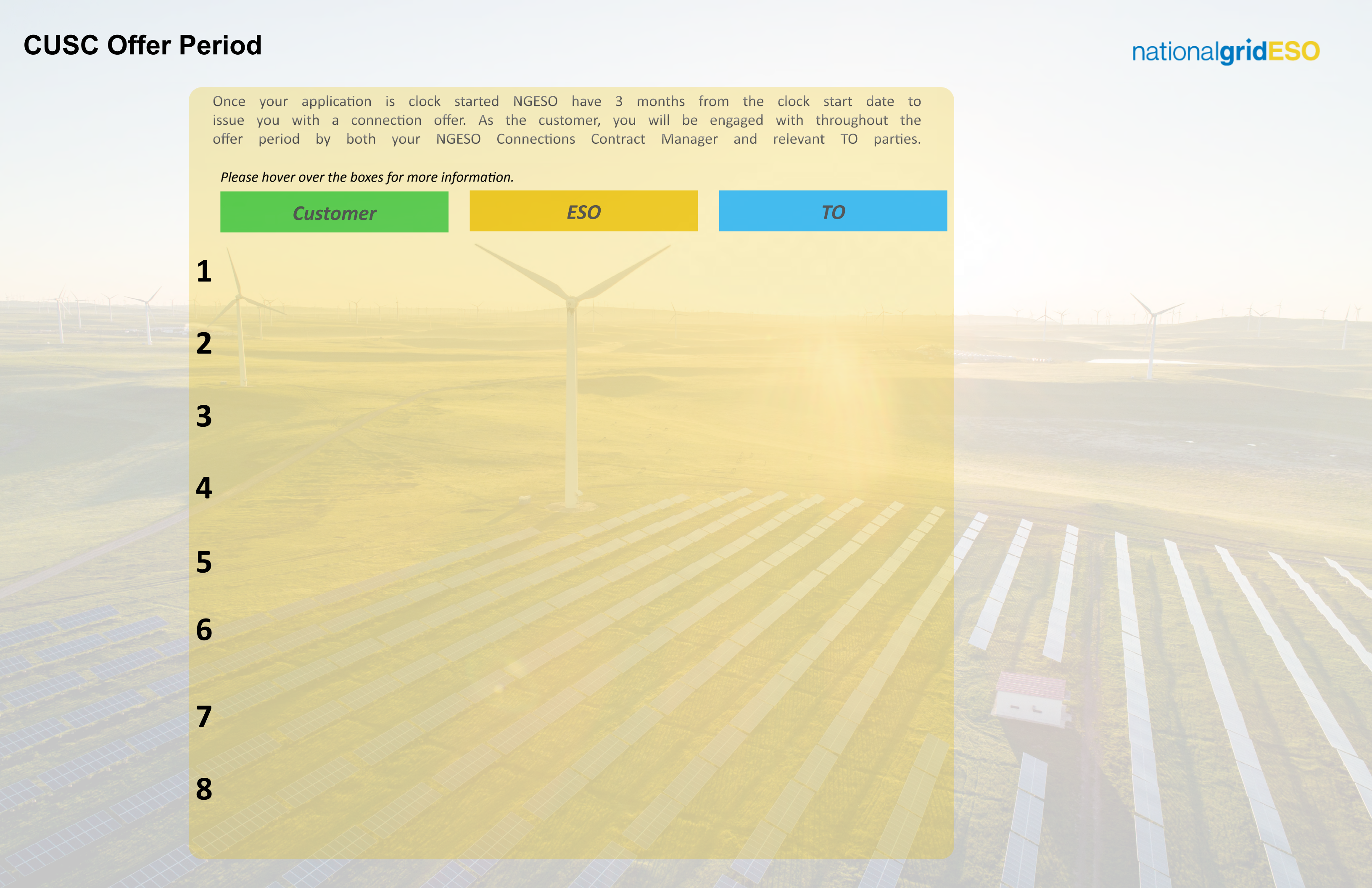
# CUSC Offer Period
