



Fewer showers in west, where more brightness too. Northwest Britain fine but very cold. Breezy in south. Tonight: Showers continue in the east, a few still running further west, with some sleet or snow on higher hills. Northwest UK, very frosty with isolated freezing fog. Windy in south.
