Key areas of discussion

- CMP326 seeks to introduce a cap on the MW element in the Holding Payment calculation to reflect reduced capability to ramp from de-loaded positions – this will be dependent on proportion of turbines available.
- Workgroup met to discuss ESO's responses to the actions raised at the meeting on 11 December 2020. These responses and the Workgroup's thoughts have been reflected in the draft Workgroup Consultation.
- The Proposer advised that, based on data from the calendar year 2020, there would be ~ £40K of savings per annum. The Proposer expects that the savings will increase year on year as they expect more wind being available for Mandatory Frequency Response (MFR) in later years. However, given the relatively small cost savings the CMP326 implementation needs to be incorporated with the implementation of ESO's new ASB settlements system (~ September 2022) to provide a positive cost benefit.
- Workgroup agreed the questions to be posed in the Workgroup Consultation, which is planned to be opened on 28 January 2021.
- No alternative solutions have been proposed yet.
