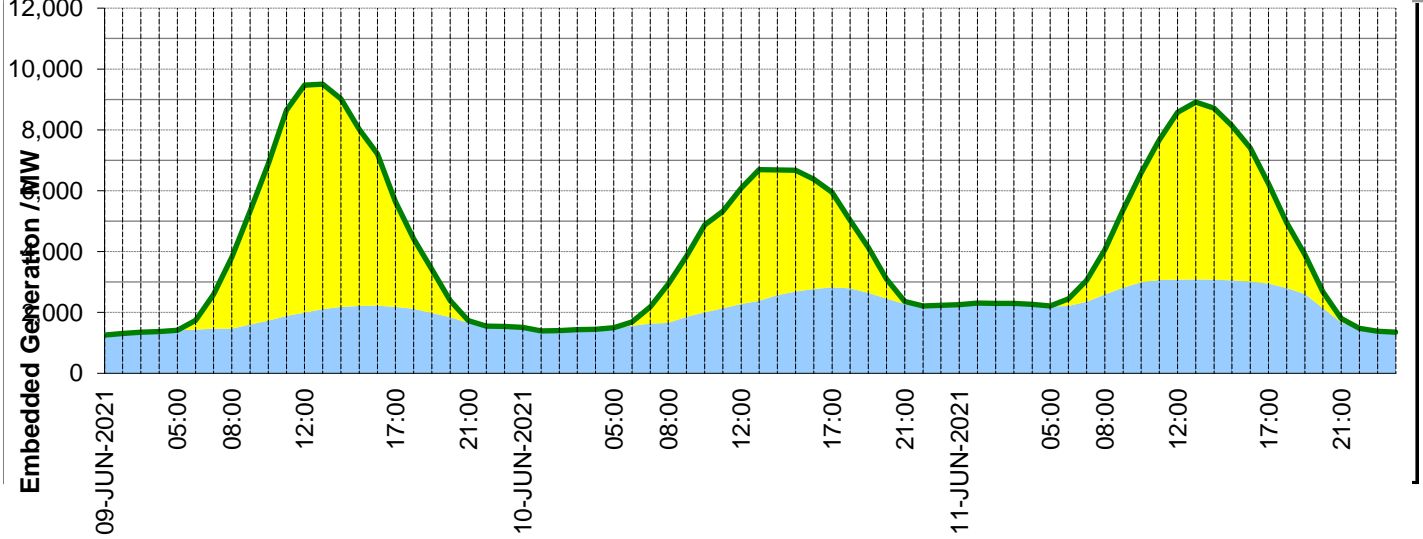

Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	<p>Today: Low cloud and fog plaguing some western and southern areas, cloud spreading across many areas by morning, with a warm humid feel. Some rain or drizzle in western fringes, heavier for a time across northwest Scotland. Breezy in the north.</p> <p>Tonight: Low cloud increasingly restricted to the far southwest. Patchy rain edging southwards; brighter, fresher conditions following, odd showers in the far north. Bright and very warm across southeast England.</p>
