





Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Northern areas seeing plenty of warm sunshine, though low cloud affecting some coasts. Cloudy and cool across central parts with rain, heavy at first, turning lighter and patchier. Brighter and warmer in the south with heavy showers and thunderstorms developing.  Tonight: Showers mostly dying out, but some persisting across southern England, perhaps heavy. Cloudy for many, but clear periods across Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England.
