





Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Rain continuing in the northwest but tending to ease, and clearing from Northern Ireland. Elsewhere, fog and low cloud slowly clearing to allow some warm sunshine for many, though staying cloudier in the far southeast Tonight: Rain moving across parts of Northern Ireland and northwest Scotland, heavy at times. South and southeast England turning cooler with fog patches. Otherwise mostly cloudy with spots of light rain.
