Workgroup Report

CMP381 – Defer exceptionally high Winter 2021/22 BSUoS costs to 2022/2023

CMP381 seeks to set a £/MWh cap on BSUoS from 1 January 2022 until 31 March 2022, due, in the view of the Proposer, to exceptional market conditions making BSUoS much higher than industry parties could reasonably have expected. The additional BSUoS costs above the cap would be deferred to the 2022/23 charging year, using the same approach as CMP350 and the recovery mechanism approved under CMP373.

CUSC Panel on 6 January 2022 unanimously agreed that the Workgroup has met its Terms of Reference and could proceed to Code Administrator Consultation, which was issued later on 6 January 2022 and will close 5pm on 10 January 2022.
