



Clouding over in the north and west with rain, preceded by hill snow in northern Scotland, moving east late morning onwards. Becoming windy with storm force winds for northwest Scotland later. Tonight: Rain moving south, followed by clear intervals and blustery showers, wintry in the north. Very windy across northern and then eastern areas, with severe gales for a time.
