



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Further rain moving eastwards across many parts, perhaps turning to snow briefly over parts of Northern Ireland, north Wales, the north Midlands and Yorkshire, a slight cover possible. Turning windy again in south, with coastal gales. Chilly in north. Tonight: Some snow for a time across Scotland. Otherwise rain is expected, heavy in the north and west, patchy and light in the south and sheltered parts elsewhere. Turning milder.
