

February/March	<p>NGESO have created the high level stakeholder engagement plan (this will be shared with JESG this week).</p> <p>We have drafted a skeleton technical procedure for further discussion with UKTSOs ahead of a future UK cross border Steerco.</p> <p>We are continuing to work on the high level principles that underpin the Day Ahead Capacity Calculation Technical Procedure.</p> <p>Clarity on how an NTC is calculated has been provided by NGESO to relevant UK TSOs.</p>

Next steps	Discuss with BEIS and OFGEM the appetite of the UKTSO's to progress these work streams.
