



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Rain clearing from southernmost counties of England. Sunny spells for many but also a scattering of showers, these heaviest and most frequent in the north with hail, sleet, and some snow on hills. Feeling rather cold. Tonight: Showers becoming confined to northern and western coasts, mainly across northern Scotland where some snow will settle on high ground. Clear skies inland allowing a widespread frost to develop.
