Industry Updates

TCA - Capacity calculation and RD CT update provided by Osaaf Syed, NGENO

Osaaf Syed provided an update on the Day Ahead Capacity Calculation [details available on the slides](#).

Osaaf also shared information that with the latest developments on the NI Protocol it could lead to an impasse with the EU TSO's, with the EU commission potentially suspending cooperation across the TCA workstreams. Work will continue and UK TSO's are well placed to continue engagement with EU TSO's when any impasse eases. Dialogue with SONI and I-SEM will continue.
