

Headline Report – 29 June 2022

System Operator Transmission Owner Code (STC) Panel

The STC Panel Headline Report is produced after every Panel and aims to provide an overview of the key decisions made. Minutes for this meeting will be published separately.

Approval of Panel Minutes

The meeting minutes from the Panel on 25 May 2022 were approved and these will be uploaded to our website.

New Modifications

The following new Modification Proposals were presented to the Panel:

CM083 ‘Workgroup Quoracy Improvements’

CM083 seeks to update quoracy rules for modifications where there is limited STC Party impact.

The Panel unanimously agreed that **CM083** should follow the Self Governance route and proceed to Code Administrator Consultation.

CM084 ‘Clarify STCP Modification approach on Cross Code Impacts’

CM084 seeks to amend the governance rules to be more prescriptive of the interactions and timings for STC Panel to better consider STCP changes stemming from cross-code modifications.

The Panel unanimously agreed that **CM084** should follow the Standard Governance route and proceed to a Workgroup. The Panel agreed the Terms of Reference for the Workgroup.

The following new draft Modification Proposals were presented to the Panel:

PM0126 'CUSC Modification 'Transmission Impact Assessment Process''

PM0126 seeks to facilitate an aggregated assessment that mitigates the need to assess individual smaller connections making it easier for all parties to get an accurate view of any works required.

This modification is intended to be formally presented for Panel vote ~ October 2022.

New / Pending Authority Decisions

Ofgem provided an update on Modifications that are awaiting their decision or have been decided upon since the last STC Panel on 25 May 2022.

Decisions since last STC Panel

There are no Ofgem decisions on STC Modifications since the last STC Panel.

Awaiting Decisions

The STC position is summarised below:

Modification	What this seeks to achieve	Expected Decision Date
CM078	Seeks to make changes to the System Operator Transmission Owner Code to reflect CUSC modification CMP328 relating to Transmission connections that trigger an impact assessment on the Distribution network.	30 November 2022, which is at the same time as the associated CUSC Modification (CMP328).

Ofgem publish a table that provides the expected decision date, or date they intend to publish an impact assessment or consultation, for code modifications/proposals that are with them for decision. This was last updated on 22 June 2022 and is published [here](#).

Draft Final Modification Reports

The following Draft Final Modification Reports were presented to the Panel:

CM080 'Transmission Impact Assessment process in relation to CMP298'

CM080 seeks to include a process for aggregated assessment of Distributed Generators that impact (or may impact) on the National Electricity Transmission System.

Panel's recommendation vote was postponed by the Chair to July 2022 Panel as Panel had not received all relevant documentation and there are legal text changes for Panel to consider.
