



Otherwise, cloud breaking to allow sunny spells, before a band of rain across the northwest moves east across other northern and western parts. Sunshine and showers into northwest later. Tonight: Windy in the north with scattered showers, some heavy in the northwest. Rain, possibly heavy moving east across rest of England, then mostly dry.
