TEC Amnesty

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What is Transmission Entry Capacity (TEC) Amnesty? #Agora22

Invite all parties with connection agreements listed on the TEC register (i.e. generation developers) to confirm whether they would be willing to terminate their agreement at no cost.

The need to run this event is driven by the continuous growth of the contracted background, which is now over 300GW, adding to the pressure on the transmission network to be able to meet the demand to connect generation at a pace when it is driving further wider and enabling works to reinforcement or build new network.

The last TEC Amnesty event was ran in 2013

This opportunity applies only to Transmission Bilateral Connection Contracts and looks to provide the opportunity for parties to waiver costs associated with:


- Terminating Connection Agreements

Yes it will, however it will mean that the participant will lose the right to participate in the balancing mechanism and lose their TEC, they will however still retain their Connection Agreement and Capacity with the Distribution Network Operator.
