3	Do you have any other comments?	<p>The baseline legal text already contains requirements for cross code working and processes for STCP changes with a material impact so the benefits of this modification are minimal, however, the proposed modification does make some minor clarifications which may improve parties understanding.</p> <p>The question that the modification seems to be trying to address is how to require changes in one code that then cause consequential changes to the STC to take account of this in a timely manner. This feels to be more of a matter for CACOP coordination or perhaps a change to the code(s) causing the initial change.</p> <p>We have also provided some comments on a draft copy of the legal text and email attached following some issues with referencing and the cross code change definition.</p>
