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## Key areas of discussion

### Introduction and Workgroup Objectives

The Chair provided an introduction and outlined the objectives of the Workgroup shown on the slides.

#### Ofgem

Ofgem were invited to give their views on the work group meetings to date however, an Ofgem representative advised that at this stage in the process they would be unable to make any comments. Ofgem reminded Workgroup Members to ensure that all information has been collected to enable the regulator to make an informed decision. Any reports being sent back can cause significant delays in the timeline.

The Chair re-iterated what the Ofgem representative had said, and to ensure that the group works collectively to get it right the first time.

Discussions were then held around timescales concerning the Workgroup Consultation document and whether the document being sent out should be pushed back until further information was obtained.

#### Alternatives Vote

The Chair shared the Alternative and Workgroup Vote Form with the Workgroup Members and asked whether everyone was comfortable with voting. With no objections, the Chair went through the form with each eligible Workgroup Member and confirmed their votes at Stage 2a - Assessment Against Objectives of the form.

The outcome of the vote was that WAGCM1 was the preferred option.

#### Review Workgroup Consultation

Workgroup Members considered the Workgroup Consultation and the Chair asked whether anyone had any questions. Workgroup Members queried how detailed the document needed to be, and discussions were held around whether there should be a delay in sending out the document until further data had been gathered. A Workgroup Member questioned whether it should be held off until Baringa confirmed if they were able to provide additional data. The Proposer had reassured Workgroup Members that they had made contact but was still awaiting a reply and would chase. The Proposer also advised that there was no surety that the data would be shared and suggested that they move to consultation

The Chair explained that the document is a summary of what has been discussed in workgroup meetings to this point and would give industry an opportunity to comment or suggest a further alternative.

Concerns were then raised about the current form of the document and wanted to ensure that the document reflects opposing views regarding ramping arrangement.

The Chair queried whether Workgroup Members needed more time to consider the Workgroup Consultation and deliberations were held around the timeline and sending the document out to industry. It was agreed that Workgroup Members would have a further week to consider and to return any comments by 6<sup>th</sup> July. ESO will collate comments and produce a final form to be sent out to industry on the 10<sup>th</sup> July 2023.
