



Strong winds over hills and coasts in the northwest. Drier in the south with sunny spells along southern coasts. Near average temperatures. Tonight:  Some rain the northern and central parts, mostly light with the odd heavier outbreak in southern Scotland. Drier elsewhere with some sunny spells towards southern England.
