Dear Gurpal,

This is the Grid Code Review Panel's Self-governance Statement to the Authority for Grid Code Modification Proposal GC0171. National Grid ESO has prepared this Self-Governance Statement on behalf of the Grid Code Review Panel and submits it to you in accordance with the Grid Code.

On 30 May 2024, the Grid Code Review Panel considered GC0171 and confirmed unanimously that it meets the Self-governance criteria.

As such, GC0171 is unlikely to discriminate between different classes of Grid Code Parties and is unlikely to have a material effect on:

- Existing or future electricity customers;
- ii) Competition in the generation, distribution, or supply of electricity or any commercial activities connected with the generation, distribution or supply of electricity,
- iii) The operation of the National Electricity Transmission System
- iv) Matters relating to sustainable development, safety or security of supply, or the management of market or network emergencies
- v) The Grid Code's governance procedures or the Grid Code's modification procedures
