



Outbreaks of rain elsewhere at first but turning drier and brighter and somewhat fresher from the west throughout the day. Tonight: Rain across the north gradually moving a little further south throughout the night. Southern England and south Wales remaining mostly dry with clear spells, but feeling a little cooler.
