



Sunny spells across Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England, but a few slow-moving showers developing here. Feeling warmer in any sunny spells. Tonight: Showers in the north tending to fade as clear spells develop. Cloud and rain will continue to affect much England and Wales, but this becoming increasingly fragmented later.
