# **Code Administrator Meeting Summary**

#### Key areas of discussion

The Chair welcomed Workgroup members and advised that the agenda for today's meeting would be looking to review and finalise the CMP430 Workgroup Report and the comments attached.

#### CMP430 Workgroup Report (Confirm Workgroup approval)

The Chair advised Workgroup members that this session was an opportunity to review the comments remaining on the Workgroup Report, and discuss and resolve any outstanding matters before sending out the final version.

A member from the ESO Revenue team was in attendance to assist with a Workgroup member's comments on points a. and b. under the 'Proposer's solution', which describes the scenarios that could be at risk of a change in charging methodology under the proposed solution. A Workgroup member raised a query when reviewing the report that some customer types would lose the embedded benefit. It was clarified that although they lose the embedded export payment based on Triad, they will still receive a benefit as the 4pm-7pm methodology is charged on net consumption so any export would reduce their charge.

All Workgroup members were happy with the clarification and the report was updated.

A Workgroup member shared information relating to the Electricity Supply Licence Standard Licence Conditions to clarify P432 interactions with the proposed solution. Other minor wording amendments were also shared, agreed by the Workgroup and updated in the report.

On the Workgroup report under 'Impacts to Industry Systems and Processes' it was noted by the Proposer that further information was needed for this section. The information had been requested through the Workgroup Consultation but with limited responses. It was suggested in an earlier Workgroup that a question be added to the Code Administrator Consultation to understand further how industry could be impacted.

The Proposer advised that an additional paragraph has been added, to cover the withdrawal of CMP431 and therefore removing co-dependency references throughout the report.

It was agreed by Workgroup members that industry would be familiar with the term 'All reasonable steps' in line with SLC 12.29.
