1. Introductions, Apologies and Declarations of Interest

- 10463. Apologies were received from Matthew White.
- 10464. The Chair introduced Claire Newton to the Panel as the new National Grid ESO Panel member, replacing Jamie Webb.
- 10465. No declarations of interest were noted by the Panel.

2. Minutes from previous meetings

10466. The minutes from the Panel meeting held on 30 May 2024 will be brought to the 25 July 2024 Panel meeting for approval.

3. Review of actions log

ML gave an update on the open actions, as follows:

- 10467. **Action 456 –** GS shared details of an invitation to Panel members to an Ofgem Strategic Direction Statement (SDS) Workshop.
- 10468. **Action 457** ML advised that the additional clarity/amendments requested by the Panel had been incorporated into <u>GC0171</u> ahead of it going out to Code Administrator Consultation, and that parties on the Distribution Code circulation list had also been made aware of the Consultation. The Panel agreed to close this action.
- 10469. Action 458 to remain open, with a further update to be given at the July 2024 Panel.
- 10470. **Action 459** to remain open, with a further update to be given at the August 2024 Panel.

4. Chair's update

10471. There were no Chair updates.

5. Authority Decisions

10472. GS advised that due to the Pre-election period Ofgem have no updates. Work will continue during this time but the expected decision dates which may change. A further update will be provided at the July 2024 Panel meeting.

6. New Modifications

GC0169: Material Grid Code Changes arising from Grid Code Modification GC0136

- 10473. ML advised that <u>GC0169</u> was being re-presented to the Panel as it had been split into two separate modifications <u>GC0169</u> and <u>GC0173</u>.
- 10474. AJ gave a presentation on G<u>C0169</u>, which aims to address several non-specialist changes identified following Grid Code Modification <u>GC0136</u>: Non-material changes to the Grid Code following implementation of the EU Connection Codes.
- 10475. AJ explained that that one of the issues identified following Grid Code Modification <u>GC0136</u> changes to clause CP.A.3.2.1, which related to modelling and control system performance was of a specialist nature and would no longer be addressed in either <u>GC0169</u> or <u>GC0173</u>. Instead, a bespoke modification would be raised to look into this as it would require specialist input and resource.

- 10476. The Panel questioned when this bespoke modification would be raised. AJ agreed to look into this and update a future Panel **Action 460.**
- 10477. The Panel unanimously agreed that <u>GC0169</u> should follow the Standard Governance route and proceed to a single joint Grid Code/Distribution Code Workgroup.
- 10478. The Panel agreed the Terms of Reference (ToR) for <u>GC0169</u> after amendments were made to ToR item (e).

GC0173: Consistency of Technical and Compliance Requirements between GB and European Users

- 10479. AJ gave a presentation on <u>GC0173</u>, which aims to ensure alignment between the Grid Code Connection Conditions and European Connection Conditions and interactions with the Compliance Processes and European Compliance Processes in addition to a data clarification in the Planning Code in respect of thermal storage technologies.
- 10480. AJ advised that it would be beneficial if Mike Kay could join the Workgroup, due to his background and experience **Action 461**.
- 10481. The Panel unanimously agreed that <u>GC0173</u> should follow the Standard Governance route and should proceed to a single joint <u>GC0169/GC0173</u> Grid Code/Distribution Code Workgroup.
- 10482. The Panel agreed the Terms of Reference for GC0173.

GC0174: Removal of obligation to provide EU Transparency Availability Data as specified in OC2.4.7

- 10483. DH gave a presentation on G<u>C0174</u>, which aims to remove the obligation for parties to submit EU Transparency Availability Data as specified in OC2.4.7, following the approval of BSC Modification <u>CP1583</u> (Rationalising publication of European Transparency Regulation data on Elexon Systems).
- 10484. The Panel discussed the following topics:
 - a. Possible non-compliance with REMIT if these obligations on Users are only written within the Grid Code and subsequently removed by <u>GC0174</u>. Where are the REMIT obligations captured; are they in the BSC or another code?
 - b. DH confirmed that GC0174 had been reviewed and signed off by the ESO legal team.
 - c. Whether any references to BMRS needed to be removed from the Grid Code.
 - d. TM noted that the removal of any duplication to submit data, impact on Users and the implications of removing this obligation in the Grid Code should be made clearer within the consultation document.

Post Panel Note: Elexon have confirmed no Grid Code changes will be required in relation to the BMRS in the BSC or the Grid Code. This is because the BSC does not specifically call out BMRS as the technology platform, rather the references/obligations are to the services (data provisioned) and operationally running the service by the central systems 'Agents' – BMRA. For the purposes of the BSC, Insights Platform is still the BMRS and the BMRA role defined in the BSC have been contractualised to appoint relevant service providers.

10485. The Panel agreed that further clarification on the scope, solution and implications of GC0174 were required before a decision could be made by the Panel on the Governance route. The Panel requested under Grid Code Governance Rule (GR) 19.2.(b) that DH further develop the Modification Proposal and bring it back to the July 2024 Grid Code Review Panel.

7. In flight modification updates

GC0155: Clarification of Fault Ride Through Technical Requirements

10486. ML explained that the Proposer of GC0155 was working with Andrew Larkin (AL) on the concerns he had raised in his email to the Grid Code Review Panel and that AL would also be attending the next Workgroup meeting. ML advised that an updated timeline for GC0155 would also be presented to the July 2024 Panel.

GC0166: Introducing new Balancing Programme Parameters for Limited Duration Assets

10487. ML advised that the <u>GC0166</u> workgroup consultation was due to go out this week, but due to the un-availability of subject matter experts this did not happen. An updated timeline for <u>GC0166</u> will be presented to the July 2024 Panel.

8. Workgroup Reports

10488. There were no updates for the Panel.

9. Draft Final Modification Reports

10489. There were no updates for the Panel.

10. Prioritisation Stack

- 10490. ML presented the prioritisation stack to the Panel. The Panel agreed to place the new modification GC0173 as fifth on the prioritisation stack in line with GC0169.
- 10491. The Panel questioned why GC0159 and GC0163 were greyed out on the stack.
- 10492. ML advised that the Panel were still awaiting clarification from the Authority on the wording of CATO licenses before they could agree on next steps for GC0159 and that GC0163 was currently in its appeal window which closed on the 28 June 2024. As both modifications could potentially come back into the stack they had been greyed out and left on there.
- 10493. The Panel agreed to un-grey <u>GC0159</u> to avoid any confusion and for it to remain on the stack.
