ESO

1. Introductions, Apologies and Declarations of Interest

- 10559. Apologies were received from Alan Creighton, David Monkhouse and Noel McGoldrick.
- 10560. No declarations of interest were received.

2. Minutes from previous meeting

10561. The meeting minutes from the Grid Code Review Panel held on 25 July 2024 were approved subject to the incorporation of amendments from AJ.

3. Review of actions log

- 10562. LT gave an update on the open actions as follows:
- 10563. Actions 456, 459, 462 and 463 are to remain open.
- 10564. Action 460, a new modification to look into CP.A.3.2.1. no longer needs to be raised. The Panel agreed to close this action.

4. Chair's update

10565. The Chair advised there were no updates this month.

5. Authority Decisions

- 10566. GS explained that, due to the complexity and wide-ranging impacts of GC0117, the Authority will be consulting with Industry on their draft decision letter before publishing their final decision. GS also advised that the expected decision date for GC0172 would be confirmed shortly, but that it was likely to be the end of November/beginning of December 2024.
- 10567. In relation to Energy Code Reform, GS gave an update on the Strategic Direction Statement (SDS) and advised there had recently been a series of workshops with code panels and code administrators and these insights will shape development going forward. The next opportunity to contribute to development of the SDS will be in their winter consultation. The Chair noted that this would be an appropriate milestone for the Panel to receive another update from the Ofgem team.
- 10568. GS advised that the Authority has commenced publishing again and are in the process of confirming new expected decision dates (EDD's) for code modifications. They expect to publish an updated register by the end of August/beginning of September 2024.

6. New modifications

10569. There were no new modifications presented to the Panel.

7. In flight modification updates

GC0155: Clarification of Fault Ride Through Technical Requirements

10570. LT gave an update on this modification to advise that there would be a timeline update, expected to be presented to the Panel in October.

GC0168: Submission of Electro Magnetic Transient (EMT) Models

10571. LT advised the Panel members that this modification was not following the original proposed timeline. This is because the Proposer is doing a lot of work in the



background to explore the scale of the problem, develop the solution and start drafting the legal text prior to Workgroups starting, in order to to make them as productive as possible. This will come back to the Panel with an updated timeline once it is ready.

<u>GC0166: Introducing new Balancing Mechanism Parameters for Limited Duration</u> Assets

10572. RL advised the Panel that the timeline on this modification is going to be extended. LT confirmed that it would be coming to the September Panel.

GC0139: Enhanced Planning-Data Exchange to Facilitate Whole System Planning

- 10573. LT presented the updated timeline for GC0139 to the Panel, noting that additional time is required to review legal text and ensure that the terminology used is consistent.
- 10574. The Panel approved the new timeline as submitted in the Panel papers.

GC0164: Simplification of Operating Code No.2

- 10575. LT presented the updated timeline for GC0164 to the Panel, noting that further Workgroups are required to enable wider industry feedback to be considered, along with further assessment of the legal text.
- 10576. The Panel approved the new timeline as submitted in the Panel papers.

GC0159: Introducing Competitively Appointed Transmission Owners

- 10577. LT explained that the Authority guidance had changed, and they no longer expected CATOs to have their own transmission area. Consequently, the definition of Relevant Transmission Licensee consulted on at Code Administrator Consultation was no longer in line with this guidance, but the alternative definition which was suggested as part of the Code Administrator Consultation was.
- 10578. Panel members highlighted that there could be other wider implications arising from this, as all the other cross code CATO modifications have been sent to the Authority on the presumption that CATOs would have their own transmission area.
- 10579. LT agreed to raise the Panels concerns with the Panel secretaries across the other codes **Action 464**
- 10580. The Panel discussed the proposed legal text amendment and agreed that the change was not typographical. The Panel directed the Workgroup to review the change and any associated impacts on the legal text, prior to the modification proceeding to a second Code Administrator Consultation.
- 10581. The Panel also requested to review the second the Code Administrator Consultation via email prior to it being published.

8. Workgroup Reports

10582. There were no Workgroup Reports presented to the Panel.

9. Draft Final Modification Reports

10583. There were no Draft Modification Reports presented to the Panel.

10. Discussion on Prioritisation

- 10585. The Panel discussed the importance of GC0159 being submitted to the Authority in a timely manner due to the implications on the associated CATO modifications which are currently with the Authority for decision. Therefore, it was placed at position 1 in the Prioritisation Stack.

10586. There were no updates presented to the Panel.

10587. There were no updates presented to the Panel.

13. Governance

10588. There were no updates presented to the Panel.

14. Grid Code Development Forum (GCDF)

10589. CN advised Panel that the GCDF was held on 07 Aug 2024 and covered:

- An Overview of RfG2.0, DCC2.0 and HVDC2.0,
- GB Grid Forming (GBGF) Further code change Proposals and
- Development of a portal for submitting Grid Code data.

- 10591. CN advised that the next GCDF meeting is planned for 04 September 2024, and the deadline for agenda items is 28 August 2024.

15. Standing Groups

Distribution Code Review Panel Update

- 10592. GV advised that the Distribution Code Consultations on EREC G99 and G98 have now closed, and that the ENA are currently reviewing the consultation responses.
- 10593. The ENA received a response to their Accelerated Loss of Mains letter from Ofgem, and are currently considering its contents.

Joint European Stakeholder Group (JESG)

10594. LT stated that the JESG meeting planned for 13 August was cancelled due to lack of agenda items. The next meeting is planned for 10 September 2024.

10596. RR informed the Panel members that the System Integration Testing cycle 3 phase of the Market-Wide Half-Hourly Settlement (MHHS) has been delayed and is now scheduled to begin in October 2024. The 'Go Live' date is likely to be postponed. Stakeholders can expect further communication on this matter soon.

17. Challenges to Modification progress

10597. LT advised that, between May to July 2024, there were three individual timeline delays. One was due to having to await Authority guidance, another due to additional time being needed to ensure the legal text was correct; and the final one was due to the complexity of the modification.

18. Horizon Scan

10598. LT presented the Horizon Scan and explained that:

- Further modifications would be raised under Digitalised Whole System Technical Code once GC0164 had concluded.
- Conversations were ongoing with the Balancing Programme team to establish what further code changes were needed.
- An Offshore Coordination modification had already been raised for the SQSS and a Grid Code modification would follow later in the year.
- The Grid Code, CUSC and STCP proposals to remove fax machines are expected to be raised in September 2024.

19. Electrical Standards

10599. There were no updates presented to the Panel.

20. Code Administrator Update

10600. LT advised that, in relation to the Grid Code Panel elections, the schedule 1 List including Materially Affected Parties was sent out to Industry for them to review. The election guide will be published on the 23 August 2024 and nominations will open on 03 September 2024.

21. Any Other Business (AOB)

10601. A panel member noted the PN accuracy presentation that was given last month and explained that it would be very useful if any future developments in this area could be provided to stakeholders by the ESO as it is of great interest. The Chair asked for that to be done via the GCDF.

22. Close

10602. The Chair thanked the Panel for their time and contribution and brought the meeting to a close.
