#### 1. Introductions, Apologies and Declarations of Interest

#### 2. In flight modification updates

# <u>CMP434 Implementing Connections Reform</u> & <u>CMP435 Application of Gate 2 Criteria to</u> existing contracted background Timeline Updates

- 12597. ML explained to the Panel that the objective of the Special Panel was to talk through the proposed timelines for CMP434 and CMP435 ahead of submitting to the Authority.
- 12598. ML advised that in the 12 July 2024 Special CUSC Panel the timelines which were discussed were based on an Implementation date of 01 January 2025. The Panel had asked for the ESO to have a conversation with the Authority and be certain that the implementation for the 01 of January was essential.
- 12599. ML confirmed that this conversation had happened, alongside the new additional requirements coming from the Clean Power 2030 letter, it was confirmed that 01 January 2025 is not crucial for implementation.
- 12600. ML talked the Panel through the proposed timelines highlighting:
  - where possible the Workgroup meetings were planned around other known Industry activities
  - where there are Workgroup meetings on consecutive days it is not anticipated that the outputs of the key objectives for the meetings are reliant on each.
  - the key objectives are planned to allow additional review time between topics, advising that if the objectives can be achieved in less Workgroup meetings, then they will be removed ASAP.
- 12601. ML explained that the Code Administrator Consultation is planned for the 11 November 2024 to the 22 November 2024 and the Draft Final Modification Reports (DFMR) will be sent to Panel on the 13 December 2024. FMR will be sent to Ofgem on the 20 December 2024 and the decision is expected in Q1 2025.
- 12602. GG asked as there was a substantial amount of reading material for the Workgroup Consultation if the Panel could receive the CAC responses on the 25 November 2024 rather than waiting for the DFMR on the 13 December 2024. ML agreed with the suggestion.
- 12603. KH asked if a further modification from the ESO is to be expected taking into consideration the Open letter from the Government, and if these timelines have taken this into consideration. JN advised that they considered the letter fell into the remit of the Methodologies rather than the Code Modifications.
- 12604. GG pointed out that the Authority blog refers to the financial instruments and asked if there was to be a financial instruments modification the timelines does not allow time for it to start until November.
- 12605. ML advised that this had been taken into consideration when planning the timelines, considering the information available at this point.
- 12606. The Panel agreed unanimously with the revised timelines.

# **ESO**

12607. LC advised that Ofgem will be publishing an Open Letter imminently with an update on the Connections Reform process, and next steps for developing and consulting on policy proposals in this area.
