



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: Outbreaks of rain in the far north gradually clearing this morning, otherwise a dry start with some bright or sunny spells. A band of rain and strong winds however will move into western areas, reaching the Midlands by dusk. Tonight: Rain, heavy at times, moving slowly northeastwards, accompanied by strong winds, especially across the southwest. Largely dry with clear spells for much of Scotland and the west of Northern Ireland.
