



Response Release 3 - November 2024 update

Dynamic Response Release 3 go live.

Ofgem has approved 10 of the 12 changes proposed in our <u>Frequency Response Release 3 submission</u>, with 2 changes to be resubmitted and published when we have more certainty on delivery timescales. Frequency Response Release 3 includes changes to improve system security and the efficiency of the market, full details on the changes can be found <u>here</u>. The new <u>Service Terms</u> and <u>Procurement Rules</u> are now published and in effect from Friday 15 November 2024.

The table below shows which changes will go live immediately and which follow in 2025.

8 Maximum sell size	Publish for immediate go live
9 Zero Deadband for non-energy limited assets	Republish closer to go live (expected early 2025)

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10 Transfer: pay secondary provider	Publish for immediate go live
11 Updates to Schedule 3	Publish for immediate go live
12 Other housekeeping changes	Publish for immediate go live
