



Scattered wintry showers will continue to feed inland along windward coasts exposed to the brisk northwesterly wind. Tonight: Showers will gradually fade during the evening, as cloud increases from the west. Turning increasingly unsettled overnight with heavy rain, proceeded by hill snow. Winds strengthening, with gales for some.
