Request for Information

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 6 November 2024.

Request

Your question related to Balancing Mechanism Units (BMUs) and you asked us:

Does a power station have a BM Unit(s)? or is it groups of power producers all registered together? Is it even possible in the UK to understand/know what each power station is generating per hour or per day? Or is that data simply not monitored?

Our response

We confirm that we hold information in scope of your request.

If a power station registers as a BM, we will allocate a number/code. A group of small power producers can register together by their aggregator, but we may not have visibility of each individual unit. If a power station is a BM, then we will have their operational data per hour or per





day. If, however, the registration is with the aggregator, we may not have the breakdown of each producer.
