Prioritisation Stack

The Panel discussed the prioritisation of the following modification:

Modification	Position in Prioritisation Stack	Panel Comments
<u>CMP445</u> : Pro-rating first year TNUOS for Generators	High	The majority of Panel members agreed that CMP445 should be given high priority due to the material impact this could have on parties and wider industry, however Panel noted that it would be useful to see evidence of how material this could be by seeking further information from NESO Connections and industry through forums such as TCMF. The Panel will review the priority of CMP445 in January 2025 when the data has been received, along with the other modifications in the prioritisation stack.

Every quarter the CUSC Panel hold a more in-depth review, the next in-depth review scheduled for the January 2025 Panel.

Public Workgroup Reports

No Workgroup Reports were presented to the Panel.

Draft Final Modification Reports

Two Draft Final Modification Reports were presented to the Panel.

<u>CMP441 – Reducing the credit risk of supplying non-embedded hydrogen electrolyser</u>

This modification seeks to address a discrepancy in the timing in de-energszing a non – embedded hydrogen electrolyser verses an embedded hydrogen electrolyser.

Ahead of the vote taking place, the Panel considered the legal text amendments proposed as part of the Code Administrator Consultation and agreed that they were typographical.

The Panel recommended unanimously that the Proposer's Original solution is implemented. The Final Modification Report will be submitted to the Authority on 23 December.

<u>CMP443 – Removing references to "Fax" or "Facsimile" within the CUSC</u>

This modification seeks to remove references to "fax" and "facsimile" from the CUSC in order to reflect both current and future methods of communication between relevant Users and the National Energy System Operator (NESO) due to the national decommissioning of the Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN).

The Panel agreed that a Second Code Administrator Consultation will be held for CMP443 due to missing legal text in the first Code Administrator Consultation.
