



Latest forecast (Summary)	Met Office SEPA Natural Resources Wales	Today: A band of rain, heavy in places, moves eastwards across England and Wales, reaching southeast England as just a brief period of light rain this evening. Otherwise sunny spells, with heavy and locally squally showers in the northwest. Rather windy. Tonight: Cloud and patchy rain clearing southeast England, then increasingly dry with clear periods for most. Blustery showers in northern areas, wintry on hills. Patchy frost with ice possible in north.
