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# Special CUSC Panel Headline Report February 2025

### **New Modification and Request for Urgency**

# <u>CMP448</u> Introducing a Progression Commitment Fee to the Gate 2 Connections Queue

This proposal establishes a framework to introduce an additional financial requirement on developers, that can be activated if required, to incentivise the timely removal of unviable projects from the connections queue and facilitate the more timely and efficient connection of viable projects. In doing so it will support progress towards clean power by 2030 ("CP30") and net zero targets.

The Panel by majority agreed that CMP448 met the Authority's Urgency criteria (a), and therefore recommended urgent treatment. Panel's recommendation was sent on 14 February 2025 seeking an Authority decision by 5pm on 18 February 2025.
