CM0101 Self Governance Statement

Dear Scott,

This is the STC Panel's Self-governance Statement to the Authority for STC Modification Proposal CM0101. NESO has prepared this Self-Governance Statement on behalf of the STC Panel and submits it to you in accordance with the STC.

On 26 February 2025, the STC Panel considered CM0101 and confirmed unanimously that it meets the Self-Governance criteria.

As such, CM0101 is unlikely to discriminate between different classes of STC Parties and is unlikely to have a material effect on:

- I. Existing or future electricity customers;
- II. Competition in the generation, distribution, or supply of electricity or any commercial activities connected with the generation, distribution or supply of electricity,
- III. The operation of the National Electricity Transmission System
- IV. Matters relating to sustainable development, safety or security of supply, or the management of market or network emergencies
- V. The STC's governance procedures or the STC's modification procedures
